

### **Tagging List of Fish and Minimum Tagging Lengths**

As a general Rule in using the Standard Tags, the minimum tag length is 200mm. However, there are some small tag guns that can be used in certain projects where fish down to 150mm can be tagged. The smaller tags are generally used in stocking programs to tag fish between 150mm and 200mm and where we are monitoring recruitment. (e.g. Barramundi)
